




Monster cathedral in Sevilla




View from the Giralda, an Arab tower updated by the Christians.

Lots of folks near Puerta del Sol in Madrid




Ham. Ham. Ham. They like their ham in Spain.

Picasso's Guernica is in the Reina Sofia museum.




The square below our hotel room in Madrid.
